New Business:

Smalling Road-Central Community Christian Church: Need 19 post for guardrail driven. Superintendent Colbaugh stated the water lines may be running along the county right of way and his office is currently working with the water department to determine placement. If the water line is blocking the right-of-way and the posts have to be driven on church property that the county would need to hire someone to complete the work.

Old Bristol Highway-Dead Trees: Unable to find location of trees on first attempt, someone will go back and check again.
