Household Hazardous Waste Day is May 13 at 9 a.m. at the Reycling Center.

**New Business:** 

Mr. Alan Williams presented information to the committee regarding the need for a comprehensive boundary survey and permitted air space survey. There is an area in the landfill that was backfilled after the flood of 1998 that is supposed to be open for drainage. The material buried there must be removed and redistributed to permitted areas of the landfill. A comprehensive survey is needed to ascertain the usable life remaining of the current landfill. The survey cost is estimated at \$18,800 and will have to be sent out for competitive bid process. Motion was made by Peters and seconded by Collins to begin the bid process for the survey, and passed on a unanimous roll call vote.

There was an accident involving a dumpster truck and a county school maintenance vehicle. Insurance

will cover the damages.

Director Lyons' Report: Talking points from earlier in the meeting were recapped. Commissioner Ward stated that he is glad

we are looking at how long the current landfill will remain operable and stressed the need to plan ahead.
