



EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 4
EXTENDING THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY IN
CARTER COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2020, I issued an Executive Order declaring a Local State of Emergency in Carter County, Tennessee which included a Safer at Home Directive and mandated the closure of Non-Essential Businesses and Services; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2020, I issued Executive Order No. 2 extending the Local State of Emergency for an additional period of seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2020, I issued Executive Order No. 3 extending the Local State of Emergency for an additional period of seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the continuing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and the ongoing threats to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Carter County, it is in the public interest that the Local State of Emergency be extended once again for an additional period of seven (7) days pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 58-8-104, Tenn. Code Ann. § 58-2-110(3)(A), and such other authority vested in me as the Mayor of Carter County, Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Russell Barnett, Mayor of Carter County, Tennessee, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me, do hereby issue this Executive Order and direct the following:

1. The Local State of Emergency declared by my original Executive Order dated March 30, 2020, which became effective at 12:01 a.m. on April 1, 2020, and which was subsequently extended for an additional period of seven (7) days pursuant to Executive Order No. 2, and extended again for an additional period of seven (7) days pursuant to Executive Order No. 3, is hereby extended once again for an additional period of seven (7) days for the area within the unincorporated limits of Carter County, Tennessee.

2. Therefore, the Local State of Emergency and all orders and directives included within my original Executive Order shall continue in full force and effect until April 28, 2020, at 11:59 p.m., or until rescinded, unless it is necessary to extend the same by subsequent Executive Order(s) as permitted by law.
