WHEREAS, with the growth of our great state and the need for more and more services of all-kinds, especially emergency medical services and the continuing rising costs of medical care, our agencies are constantly searching for more resources; and

WHEREAS, across our state more rural hospitals are being closed and community clinics are being downsized, requiring a great need for ambulance services as the first line of care providers and transportation from remote areas; and

WHEREAS, emergency medical services and rescue services in Carter County are provided by the Carter County Emergency Rescue Squad which responds to over 12,000 calls per year in meeting the needs of Carter County and the surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the Carter County Emergency Rescue Squad provides a vital service for the citizens of Carter County, and a great many of our citizens rely on Medicaid to obtain healthcare; and

WHEREAS, Medicaid (TennCare) reimbursement has not increased since the inception of the TN Medicaid managed care system; and

WHEREAS, Medicare rates do not reflect the actual cost to operate ambulance services and TennCare rates are, in most cases, half of what Medicare provides, forcing limitations of services and placing a greater burden on local agencies and citizens especially in areas such as Carter County; and

WHEREAS, ambulance services throughout the State, in order to meet growing emergency needs and reduce the burden on the local governments and taxpayers, need assistance in improving funding for the essential lifesaving services they provide; and

WHEREAS, increased funding will not cover the full cost of services, but it will begin an effort to aid communities as demand continues to increase for EMS system resources across the state including the costs of maintaining staff, equipment and training for pre-hospital emergency medical services, and filling the gap of the reduction in hospitals throughout Tennessee that is rendering EMS systems as the first line of care for many counties.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners for Carter County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this the 21st day of January, 2020, with a lawful quorum of said Board being present and with a majority voting in the affirmative that the Board shows its support for legislation which directs TennCare to reimburse ground ambulance providers at a rate not less than the current Medicare fee schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body does hereby pray that our State Representatives and Senators be contacted and encouraged to support legislation which directs TennCare to reimburse ground ambulance providers at a rate not less than the current Medicare fee schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its approval the welfare of the county demanding.







RESOLUTION NO. 756

"A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CURRENT COUNTY POLICY REGARDING APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDERS FOR ALL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS INVOLVING COUNTY PROPERTY."

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners for Carter County may establish certain policies and procedures for efficient operation and management of public funds; and

WHEREAS, to ensure effective management of publicly funded construction projects involving county owned property it is desirable to have certain internal controls in place regarding the authorization and approval of construction contract change orders; and

WHEREAS, the current policy regarding this issue is found in Section 3.58 of the Carter County Financial Policies and Procedure Manual and states as follows:

3.58 Change Orders

Contracts awarded for construction projects may involve change order requests at a future point. All change orders should be evaluated by the Director of Finance and affected Department Head based on the total budget for the construction project, any relevant building code or permit issues, and the terms of the scope of the work involved in the original bid. In addition, written recommendations from the project architect and contractors should be solicited in relation to the merits of the specific change order and placed in the bid file. The Director of Finance and affected Department Head shall have authority to approve change orders up to an amount that does not materially change bid results/selection.

WHEREAS, this matter was studied by the Carter County Financial Management Committee which has recommended that the current policy be amended to require additional/different approvals for construction contract change orders depending upon the cost of the proposed change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners for Carter County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this the 21st day of January, 2020, with a lawful quorum of said Board being present and with the required majority voting in the affirmative that the Board hereby adopts the following language which shall replace the current version of the change order policy found in Section 3.58 of the Carter County Financial Policies and Procedure Manual in its entirety:


3.58 Change Orders

Contracts awarded for construction projects may involve change order requests at a future point. All change orders should be evaluated by the Director of Finance and affected Department Head based on the total budget for the construction project, any relevant building code or permit issues, and the terms of the scope of the work involved in the original bid. In addition, written recommendations from the project architect and contractors should be solicited in relation to the merits of the specific change order and placed in the bid file. For all construction change orders with an estimated cost of \$5,000.00 or less, final approval in writing must be granted by the Carter County Mayor and the Chairman of the Building and Grounds Committee. For all construction change orders with an estimated cost exceeding \$5,000.00, final approval must be granted in writing by the Carter County Mayor, the Chairman of the Building and Grounds Committee, one other member of the Building and Grounds Committee. The Director of Finance must provide approval for all change orders before they are implemented."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this Resolution in its entirety shall be effective from and after its adoption, and all prior Resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed, the welfare of the county demanding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any portion of this Resolution shall be found to be in conflict with any existing or future state law, private act, or court order, the conflicting portion shall be rendered null and void and the remaining portions of this this Resolution shall remain in effect.
